**Homework** will be done online using *WeBWork*, an open-source homework system for math and sciences courses. Access information:

3. Your Username is your NetID, for example jqpublic
4. Your Password is initially set to be your 9-digit SUID. You should change it after logging in
  - The number of attempts is unlimited (There may be some restrictions in some problems). Problems can be done in any order. You do not have to do them all at once. You can also get a PDF file of the entire assignment and print it out to work offline.
  - Each Thursday night a set of WebWork problems will be assigned. They will be discussed during the following week's recitations and will be due at 11:59pm on the Sunday of that week. Namely, you will have at least 9 days to finish your hw.
  - Lowest 2 homework scores will be dropped.
  - Note that all due times are 11:59p.m. EDT (EDT - Eastern Daylight Time. This is the time zone of NY State.) If you are in another state or country, then check your time zone and submit your homework according to NY time.
  - **No extension will be given in any circumstances. If you have a valid excuse, you may be exempted from that HW. Your excuse must cover entire HW period- not Sunday or part of Sunday only. In particular, do not wait until Sunday to do your HW. "Internet problems," "Broken laptops," "WebWork down on Sunday night," etc. are not valid excuses. However, if there is a persistent WebWork Server problem which is longer than a day -24 hours-, then HW due time may be changed.**

**No written Hw:** No homework will be collected. Page 5 of the syllabus contains suggested problems for each section. These assignments will not be collected nor will they be graded. However, it is in your best interest to complete all of the assigned problems.

**Quiz:** Starting from the second week of classes, there will be a quiz in recitation similar to the homework problems. The specific sections covered by each quiz will be announced in lecture. There will be no make-up quizzes. The lowest (one) quiz score will be dropped.

**No makeup exams will be given. For students with an EXCUSED absence, the final exam score will be substituted for the missing exam score.**
