**Grading Policy:** Total points possible is  $400 = 20$  (homework) +  $40$  (quizzes) +  $240$  (mid-term exams) +  $100$  (final exam). A letter grade will be assigned based on the percentage of points that you earn:  $93\%$  to  $100\% \rightarrow A$ ,  $90\%$  to  $93\% \rightarrow A-$ ,  $87\%$  to  $90\% \rightarrow B+$ ,  $83\%$  to  $87\% \rightarrow B$ ,  $80\%$  to  $83\% \rightarrow B-$ ,  $77\%$  to  $80\% \rightarrow C+$ ,  $73\%$  to  $77\% \rightarrow C$ ,  $70\%$  to  $73\% \rightarrow C-$ ,  $60\%$  to  $70\% \rightarrow D$ , below  $60\% \rightarrow F$ .
