**Note:** In Blackboard, there is a posted list of assigned textbook (i.e. written) problems. These assignments will not be collected nor will they be graded. However, it is in your best interest to complete ALL of the assigned problems.

**Blackboard:** The syllabus, class handouts, and announcements will be posted on Blackboard. Please check Blackboard regularly for any class related information (for homework – please check WebAssign) as well as your student email, as announcements will also be sent to you via email. Grades for quizzes and exams will also be posted in the Blackboard Grade Center. Please note that your earned homework scores are given in WebAssign. **Quizzes:** Quizzes will be short and administered during recitation. The quiz questions will be similar to homework problems and lecture examples. Each quiz will cover the sections covered in lecture since the last quiz. Quiz topics and reminders will be announced on Blackboard. There are no make-up quizzes. However, to account for emergency situations up to two quizzes may be missed. If you take all of the quizzes, your lowest two quiz grades will be dropped.
